Lightning warnings the NWS won't give you

The National Weather Service issues no public warning for cloud-to-ground lightning — the biggest hazard for crews on decks, in trenches, on scaffolds and in the crane. We alert your superintendents in time to bring crews down and in, and give an all-clear so you're not losing more time than the storm takes.

Wind at your crane and lift limits

Tower cranes, mobile cranes, man-lifts and tilt-up panels each have a wind limit. You set them; we warn per site with onset and end timing — for thunderstorm gusts an hour or more ahead, and for large-scale wind events days ahead so you can plan lifts around them.

Rain and flood timing for pours and excavations

A 7-day forecast written for each jobsite tells you when the window for a pour or a dig is real. Short-fuse heavy-rain and flash-flood warnings cover open excavations, trenches and low sites in the hours before.

Every active site, not the whole county

We monitor each jobsite individually and warn only the sites in a storm's path. When a county warning includes a site but the storm won't reach it, a null-warning notification keeps that crew working. Sites come on and off the program as they open and close out.
