Lightning for public works and parks crews

The National Weather Service issues no warning for cloud-to-ground lightning — the hazard your road crews, mowing crews, utility crews, lifeguards and ball-field users face most. We warn each department in time to bring people in, and clear them to go back out.

Facility by facility, crew by crew

A county-wide warning is the one thing you already have. We monitor the courthouse, the jail, the offices, the parks and each active work zone individually, so the shelter order goes to the buildings in the storm's path and the rest of county operations keep running.

Flood timing for the crossings you close

Flash-flood warnings for the specific low-water crossings, underpasses and roads you barricade, with expected onset — so public works closes them before the first car goes in, and reopens when the water's actually down.

Days of lead for closures and pre-staging

Ice, heavy snow and large-scale wind events are warned days out — watches up to 7 days ahead, warnings by day 5, with onset and end timing — so you pre-treat roads, stage equipment, open warming centers and make the closure call the day before.
