Warnings by milepost range, not county

We load your subdivisions as corridors and your yards, bridges, sidings and known washout locations as points. A warning names the segment, the milepost range and the time window, so dispatch issues a slow order or hold for the trains that need it and the rest of the subdivision keeps moving.

Wind at your blow-over thresholds

Empty double-stacks and autoracks don't need a hurricane to leave the rail. You set the crosswind threshold by equipment and by segment; we warn on large-scale wind events days ahead by corridor, and on thunderstorm outflow and gap winds an hour or more ahead of the milepost range affected.

Washout, heat and cold for engineering

Flash-flood and heavy-rain warnings for known washout locations and bridge approaches; rail-temperature guidance for heat-related buckling and slow orders; extreme-cold outlooks for pull-aparts and switch heaters — with a 7-day outlook so maintenance-of-way plans the week around it.

Lead time measured in days for planning

Network operations plan days ahead, so we do too: a 7-day planning outlook by subdivision every morning (10 days on request), watches for large-scale wind, ice and flood events up to 7 days out, warnings by day 5, and short-fuse severe weather still at 60 minutes or more.
